

Pet Policy:

A pet is a full-fledged member of the family. We have developed these support measures based on previous rental experiences and our personal veterinary professional experience: we are confident that they will ensure you have a pleasant, safe, and relaxing stay with your beloved four-legged friends!

We strongly urge you to:

- Do not take them upstairs to the bedrooms, as this may damage the carpets.
 - Take them outside frequently to prevent them from relieving themselves in the villa, as the natural stone floor is very sensitive to the acidity of urine.
 - Never leave them alone in the villa (the villa cannot be used as a kennel, and for safety reasons, we must have secure and permanent access to the villa).
 - Accompany them when they go out into the garden, as it is not fully fenced.
 - Do not allow them to swim in the pool.
 - Ensure they behave in a friendly and respectful manner towards all strangers.
 - Remove any excrement from the garden and place it in a sealed bag in the white household waste bag.
 - For hygiene reasons, we require your veterinarian to certify three weeks prior to your arrival that your dogs are parasite-free and that they have administered a complete preventative parasite treatment (Bravecto and Drontal or equivalent). The certificate must be sent by email (alain_art@hotmail.com) before your arrival. If you forget to send this certificate, and until this oversight is rectified, your pet will be denied access to the villa.
- This last, rather restrictive measure is nevertheless necessary to ensure that no animal is the source of parasite contamination or becomes a victim of it during their stay.
